

# 3-hour resuscitation, trauma and emergencies workshop for international GPs





This 3-hour workshop\* of basics in medical emergencies is focused on **recognizing an acutely ill patient** and starting initial management of all critically ill, including **severely injured person**.

**Recognizing cardiac arrest** is a central part of the workshop where students are trained to work in a team. Resuscitation procedures are taught during simulation training, where students will gain or refresh their skills in more advanced resuscitation (drugs, defibrillation and **airway management**). All workstations are extremely dynamic and team work is expected.

#### Why this workstation?

Regardless of their specialty training, all physicians are expected to have skills and knowledge to recognize critically ill person and to start initial management. Many research have been point out the lack of such skills and inappropriate formal education. Although a cardiac arrest is quite rare in GP's office, every member of medical staff needs to recognize it, activate emergency medical services and to start basic or intermediate life support.
